Language Proficiency:

Language Comprehension (Hindi)

Language Comprehension (English)

Reading unseen passages – two passages one prose or drama and one the poem with questions on comprehension, inference, grammar and verbal ability (Prose passage may be literary, scientific, narrative or discursive).

Subject Knowledge up to Class X: This section will contain questions based on understanding and application of concepts in Science, Social science and Mathematics up to secondary level. NCERT Books to be referred.
