

Detailed Instructions for IELTS Listening Table Completion

All listening sections (1–4) have table completion questions that simply ask you to finish the table by filling in the blanks with the appropriate responses from the listening section. The major themes raised in the chats or monologues are typically covered in the table. The primary themes in sections 3 and 4 are frequently crucial academic notions and facts.

Techniques To Remember

- Pay close attention to the instructions.
- Before the recording begins, take a close look at the question set and the table.
- Look over all headings and subheadings.
- Try to anticipate what you will hear and determine what you should be listening for.
- Consider vocabulary as well as grammatical structures.
- Pay close attention to the introduction spoken.
- As you listen, respond to the questions.
- If you're unsure about the answer, write it down next to the question.
