

Detailed Instructions for IELTS Listening Matching Information

Expect to see a matching question on your test because they appear frequently in the IELTS Listening test. In parts 1 or 3, where the tape represents a dialogue between two or more people, this kind of inquiry typically emerges. You must match the two sets of information that the question will include. To properly complete matching questions, you must have a solid strategy, which you will discover in this session. The following advice can be used to achieve a high band score in this section:

Techniques To Remember

- Read the guidelines thoroughly.
- Verify the required letters and the listed categories.
- Read the sentences/phrases/words that are listed next to the question numbers and become as familiar with them as you can. All of them will be mentioned, however, they might not all be represented the same way in the text.
- Both the classes and the question statements' important words should be underlined.
- The words you have highlighted should be addressed.
- Never leave any statements unaccompanied by a letter.
