

Detailed Instructions for IELTS Listening Note Completion

All listening sections (1–4) have form completion questions that simply ask you to finish the form by filling in the blanks with the appropriate responses from the listening section. The major themes raised in the chats or monologues are typically covered in the note or table. The primary themes in sections 3 and 4 are frequently crucial academic notions and facts.

Techniques to Remember

- Pay close attention to the instructions.
- Before the recording begins, take a close look at the the form.
- Look over all headings and subheadings.
- Try to anticipate what you will hear.
- Determine what you should be listening for.
- Consider vocabulary as well as grammatical structure.
- Pay close attention to the introduction spoken.
- As you listen, respond to the questions.
- If you're unsure about the answer, write it down next to the question.
